309. 5-YEAR VERTICAL OF SINEANN OLD VINE ZINFANDEL

Experience five years of Sineann's flagship wine from the century-old, the Pines Vineyard near The Dalles – one of the oldest producing vineyard in the Pacific Northwest. The wine is dark and immensely concentrated. Great aromas, intensely flavored, with a deep, wild, gamey, dark streak that makes the wine something special. To those who wonder if Zinfandel can be ripened outside of California, winemaker Peter Rosback offers this example. Not only does Zinfandel ripen on this old vineyard, it maintains balancing acidity to produce a wine that ages beautifully.

310. 2007 BEAUX FRERES PINOT NOIR WILLAMETTE VALLEY, 1.5L MAGNUM

The 2007 Willamette Valley wine shows a delicate medium ruby color and very expressive aromas consisting of sweet cherries, a walk through the woods and a splash of white flowers.

311. 2003 SOTER BEACON HILL PINOT NOIR 1.5L MAGNUM

Because the vineyard was sold in 2005, the last Soter vintage from Beacon Hill was in 2006. Beacon Hill Pinot Noir is a structured, dense version of the varietal, built for medium to long-term cellaring. The 2003 Beacon Hill Pinot Noir is in a riper, more overtly powerful style than the 2002. With Burgundian notes of dry leaves, underbrush, and game, it features bold black cherries, Oregon blackberries, that ever-present cranberry top-note, cedar oil (a hallmark of Beacon Hill), and a wraith of marzipan. A gentle caress of tannin on the back palate promises a very bright future in the cellar.

The bright ruby color of this dark-fruited Pinot Noir is a confident representation of Oregon's 2007 vintage. Our proactive picking decisions took advantage of excellent maturity. We picked over 90% of our harvest before any rains. Only the best lots were blended or bottled. The result is a wine with compelling dark cherry fruit nuanced with hints of slate, lavender, plum and spice. The supple palate has ample weight, juicy acidity and a silky finish. The wine is precocious in development and approachability but should improve with bottle age for several years. It offers immediate enjoyment with a range of foods. A fine Pinot Noir can have no higher calling.

Nerves of steel are required of winemakers working the dizzying heights of the Dentelles de Montmirail near Gigondas. Winemaker Corinna Kruse, however, is the type of person who'd scoff at such jitters; she'd probably be first in line to go bungee-jumping, if you asked. Completely dedicated to her craft, and possessing an energy that can only be described as electric. Kruse's vineyards cling to the high-altitude slopes in the Côtes de Ventoux, bordering the craggy Dentelles. Kruse spent many a vintage working with her husband, Thierry Faravel of Domaine La Bouïssière, before establishing her own micro-domaine and a style of wine that aims to cause some serious earthquakes in this part of the southern Rhône. Very exciting; very limited.

332. SUPER COOL HUGE BOTTLE OF 1998 DUNHAM CELLARS TREY MARIE WALLA WALLA RED

🍷 Huge Magnum

Ruby-brick red, with a strong purple hue. Vibrant up-front fruit, really jumps out of the glass, with secondary notes of eucalyptus, mint and cedar. Tannins are smooth and integrated, and well in the background at this point. More structure comes from the bright acidity, which plays nicely off the dark fruit. Nice Pacific Northwest treatment of a classic Bordeaux blend.

333. 1980 SILVER OAK BONNY'S VINEYARD CABERNET SAUVIGNON 1.5L MAGNUM

Among the tapestry of historic vineyards in Napa Valley, there are a few standout names, but even fewer sites, if any, involve the rare combination of legendary wine, romance, and a touch of mystery. Bonny's Vineyard is such a place. From Bonny's Cabernet Sauvignon vines, Justin Meyer coaxed wines that were celebrated for their elegant structure, dark intense fruit, and at times controversial notes of bell pepper and eucalyptus.

Tight, tannic and full-bodied, with chewy cedar, dried currant, sage and herbal notes. Gains complexity despite the chewy tannins and may reward short-term cellaring. Drink now through 2015.
